

MARIAN WALDEMAR KUCZMA - biography.

Marian Waldemar Kuczma was born in Sanok in 1967. He studied at the Faculty of Painting, Sculpture and Graphic Art of the PWSSP (at present Academy of Fine Arts) in Wrocław.
